

# GOOD EARTH WHITE 2015



Cases produced: 465

Residual sugar: 8 g/L (0.8%)

Titrateable Acidity: 6.7 g/L

Alcohol by volume: 12.2%

**Tasting notes (from *Vinous*):** “This wine boasts a pungent nose of roses, banana and papaya. The wine sits broad and low on the palate, but the acidity quickly rushes in, sharpening the wine to a fine point.”

**Harvest notes:** A vintage with average temperatures provided ripe flavors and moderate acidity in the grapes.

**Winemaker notes:** A blend of 78% Vidal Blanc grapes (purchased from Seneca Lake vineyards), 17% estate grown Gewurztraminer and 5% Riesling. Grapes were fermented and aged separately in stainless steel; blended prior to bottling.

**Pairing Suggestions:** Appetizers, guacamole, schnitzel, Mexican food
