Job Description:

The Assistant Vineyard Manager/Assistant Winemaker will work under the supervision of the Winemaker/Vineyard Manager to care for the 10-acre vineyard and assist with wine production. Job duties include:

- pruning and tying
- shoot thinning, leaf pulling, shoot positioning, trellis management
- weeding, mowing, cover crop management
- sampling for nutrient levels and grape maturity
- integrated pest management—scouting, making recommendations and pesticide application
- keeping detailed vineyard and winery records
- hand-harvesting of estate vineyard
- operate and maintain tractor and other farm equipment
- perform cellar operations including wine transfers, filtration, additions, winery sanitation, etc.
- perform laboratory analysis as needed in the winery
- other farm and wine production duties as needed
- provide wine sales and marketing support on a limited basis when needed
