

Petillant Naturel 2024



2024 Petillant Naturel is a blend of red and white grapes from our bio-intensively farmed estate vineyard.

Cases produced: 250 / Residual sugar: 0 g/L / Alcohol by Volume: 11.2%

Tasting notes: Alluring aromas of red cherry, melon, strawberry, yeast, and vanilla accompany this lovely dark pink wine. A fine and gentle mousse combine with a soft texture for a lively sensory experience. Pure, unadulterated, and alive...this wine showcases the best of what methode ancestrale can be.

Harvest notes: Our Pet Nat was assembled over the course of the 2024 harvest, with pickings taking place throughout September and October. The bulk of the cuvée was a field blend of locally-adapted vines planted in our Good Earth Block. The balance of the cuvée was a combination of vinifera fruit that wasn't suitable for varietal wines, so we diverted it into this unique wine rather than wasting it. 2024 harvest was a dry and sunny period, resulting in good quality fruit with high ripeness levels.

Winemaker notes: The blend includes mostly Cayuga, Aravelle, and Regent, which are locally-adapted hybrids grown 100% organically in our Good Earth Block. It also includes Chardonnay, Cabernet Franc and Gewurztraminer from our estate vineyard. Fruit was pressed partially into neutral oak barriques and partially into stainless steel tanks, where 100% spontaneous fermentation took hold. Slightly before dryness was achieved, the various fermentation containers were blended, chilled and racked to reduce cloudiness. It was bottled in late November 2024, where fermentation resumed and finished, resulting in a dry wine with approximately three atmospheres of pressure. No sulfites were added.

Cellaring: This wine is meant to be consumed young. The yeast will preserve it for a few months, but it is essentially a fresh product intended for consumption within one year of bottling.
