



Dry Riesling 2024

Our best-selling wine and a benchmark for the Finger Lakes region.

Cases produced: 660

Residual sugar: 0.6% / Alcohol by Volume: 12.6% / TA: 7.05 g/L / pH: 3.34

Tasting notes: Aromas of peach, lemon, and grapefruit peel are accompanied by a rich, textured mouthfeel. Crisp acidity and a lingering finish of citrus and stone. Rich in texture.

Harvest notes: A blend of Riesling grapes from our estate vineyard and the Doyle Vineyard, both Caywood, NY locations on the east side of Seneca Lake. All grapes were grown using sustainable methods that qualify for the New York Wine & Grape Foundation's Sustainable Winegrowing Certification. Grapes were hand-picked on a variety of dates between October 8th and 22nd, 2024. 2024 was the warmest growing season on record in the Finger Lakes, a record previously held by 2012. Grapes achieved a level of ripeness not usually seen in our region, with a resulting profile of intensity and power.

Winemaking Notes: A diversity of approaches, including whole-cluster pressing, warm and cool fermentations, native and cultured yeast were used across many small lots and then blended together. Wines are never fined and minimal sulfites are added prior to bottling. Residual sugar is natural, resulting from arrested fermentation. Fermented in a mix of stainless steel and neutral oak barrels; both selected and ambient yeasts were used for fermentation.

Feather: Bald Eagle

Cellaring: Drink now to fully enjoy its' vibrancy; can be aged for 5-7 years.
